LEGAL SERVICES CELEBRATES 20TH ANNIVERSARY OF ITS JUSTICE FOR ALL BALL

ST. LOUIS -- Legal Services of Eastern Missouri (LSEM) will hold its 20th Annual Justice For All Ball on Saturday, February 27, at the Chase Park Plaza Hotel in St. Louis.

“The ball is our major fund raising event” said Dan Glazier, executive director and general counsel of LSEM. “It’s been a wonderful tradition for 20 years. We generally have 600 to 700 people in attendance at the ball. The funds raised help us provide civil legal services to the low-income community, and we’re very pleased to have so many people participate in the event. It really is a good time for a good cause.”

The black-tie event begins at 6:30 PM with cocktails and a silent auction; dinner will be served at 8:00 PM, followed by dancing to the sounds of the Soulard Blues Band. The auction will feature over 100 items, including vacation homes, premiere seats at sporting events, gourmet dinners, and an airplane ride over St. Louis. There is a special Broadway package that includes airfare for two, tickets to two Broadway shows, “The Addams Family” and “Race”, and two nights (April 9 and 10) at the Waldorf Astoria.

Honored guests will include ball co-founders Hon. Richard B. Teitelman, judge, Missouri Supreme Court, Thomas Lang, an attorney in a general practice in Clayton, and Gerald Ortvals, an attorney with Bryan Cave.

Tickets for the ball are \$175, \$200, and \$275 per person; tables of 10 may be reserved for \$1,750, \$2,000, or \$2,750.
